Couldn't detecting cybersecurity risks be as easy?

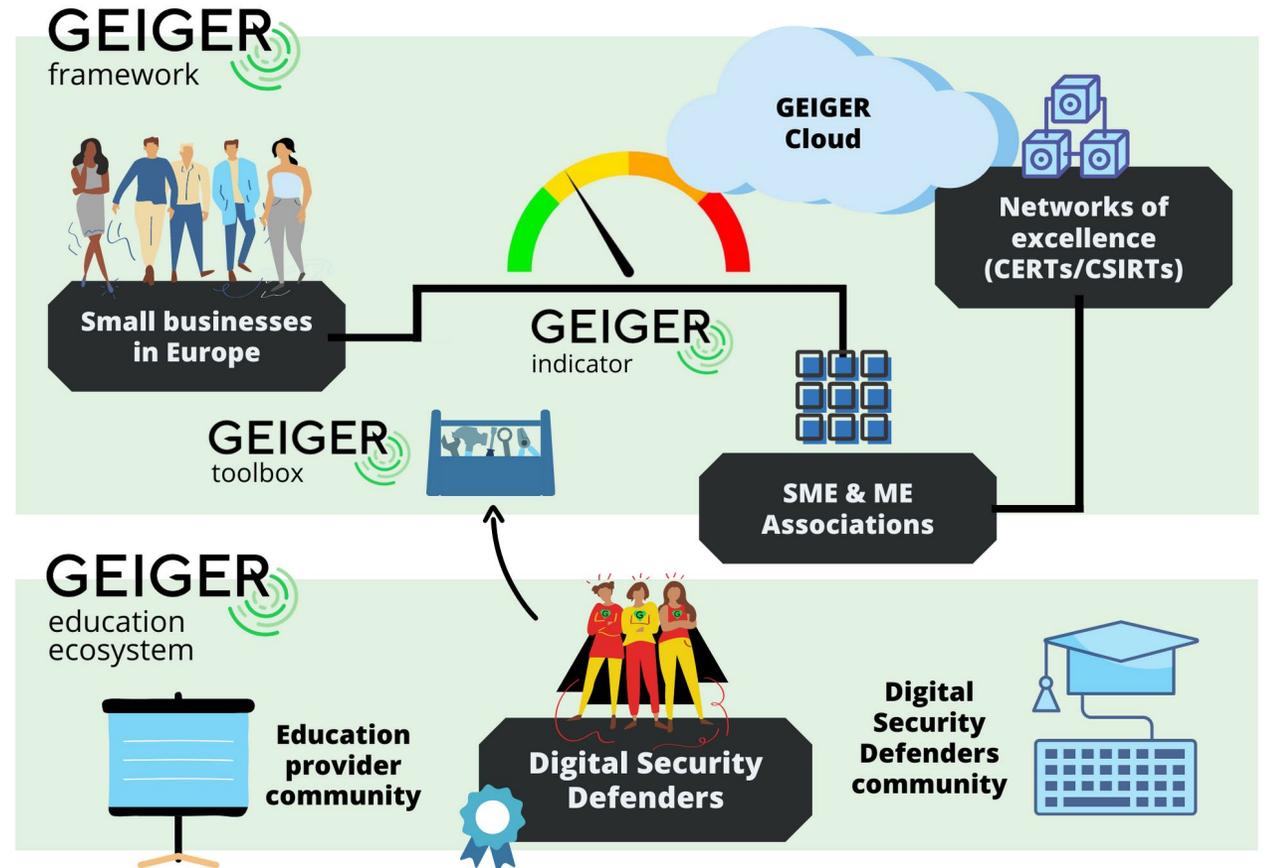


This is why we have GEIGER!
